



Scientific Collaboration Agreement

Scientific and Educational collaboration agreement has been established between the Associazione Nazionale Allevatori della Specie Bufalina (ANASB), legal office in Via F. Petrarca 42/44 Loc. Centurano - 81100 Caserta represented by its president Nicola Palmieri and International Buffalo Federation (IBF), a no profit organization with legal office, via Salaria 31, 00015 Monterotondo, represented by its General Secretary Antonio Borghese.

ANASB is a national association of breeders, that had been instituted on 1979 and recognized on the 1994 by Agricultural Ministry. The Ministry, with Ministerial Decree n° 20154 has entrusted the management of the Book to ANASB on year 2000. In the same year other decree (D.M. 201992 on July 5, 2000) recognized buffalo enrolled in Genealogical Book pertaining to the only own race Mediterranean Italian. ANASB cooperates with university, corporates, local and public authorities and the main objective is that of genetic selection, divulgating, developing, promoting the researching programs to the development of buffalo in Italy and in the world.

International Buffalo Federation (IBF) is a Scientific Association born in 1985 in Cairo, Egypt, and registered on 11/10/2004 by legal act, in the Animal Production Research Institute, Via Salaria 31, 00015 Monterotondo, Rome, Italy.

Actually IBF Members are 117, Representative of 39 Countries, they are scientists, buffalo farmers, Government technicians or working in food industry.

The IBF members are engaged in buffalo research, in all the aspects: breeding, feeding and nutrition, reproduction, genetic selection, animal health, dairy and meat production, management and training. The IBF is a well-known world organization aimed at buffalo development, in order to increase the social and economic benefits of buffalo production, nevertheless respecting the social and ecological role in many countries, as family animal in small villages (producing draft, milk, meat, manure, hide).

The objective of the agreement is to promote the activities carried out in the field of research on Mediterranean Italian Buffalo, to optimize the management in the buffalo sector, to increase dissemination of buffalo activities in the world, to organize training courses on buffalo management and industry to increase the knowledge, as well as the promotion of development's projects, particularly in foreign countries where the introduction of Mediterranean Italian genetic could help the increase of milk potential to satisfy the protein requirements for the people.


The activities envisaged in this Agreement will be implemented by the Parties under their exclusive competence.
